Meeting started by welcoming all State office bearers by President -AHPI

Following is the GIST of Discussion from the meeting:

- COVID Vaccination-Role of Private Hospitals
- Letter to PMO HR suggestions
- AHPI working with step one-give India to provide aid in the form of Oxygen Concentrators.
 Members to provide list of hospitals to AHPI.
- Violence against Hospital and Medical Personnel- AHPI to write to the Prime Minister & Health Minister.
- Free teleconsultation facility by Connect2my doctor to AHPI members and COVID 19 kits for Government and private diagnostic labs from NCBS.
- ICAI to conduct the study on costing of medical procedures along with stakeholders (AHPI, IMA, NATHEALTH, FICCI and ASSOCHAM) ICAI also to include Government bodies in the study.
- Discussion and way forward on irrational prescription of drugs by Hospitals for Covid management.
- Dr. Saumitra pointed out the WB Bengal Govt. order for Remdesivir procurement, same can only be procured and provided by Hospitals thus discouraging black marketing.
- Members encouraged the idea of single point procurement of vaccines for private hospitals. Role
 of AHPI in same to be discussed and established by AHPI committee on vaccines (announced in
 meeting with Mr Jogesh Gambhir as convener, Dr Bishnu Panigrahi and Dr Hema Divakar as
 members)

- Members highlighted importance of Oxygen Rationing
- Dr. Alex informed members regarding the vaccine supplies to private hospitals, which may take time up to 3 months
- Clarity on Vaccination Procurement by Private Hospitals still to be ascertained by all private hospitals in general and VACINE committee in particular.
- Infection in Healthcare Worker's families adding to manpower shortages in hospitals
- Sensitize providers on usage of Remdesivir
- Dr. Alex also advised members to explore options of installing inhouse oxygen generators to manage future crisis and thereafter,
- Dr Bishnu and Mr Sam Mehta to draft a letter on behalf of AHPI for Nursing Council and Government addressing shortage of nurses due to their excessive involvement in Home Care.
- Dr Bishnu to circulate the template/guidelines on management of COVID patients by Fortis.
- Oxygen committee

Dr BHAGAT was nominated as Convenor, with Ms NILANJANA and Mr SAMEER MEHTA were nominate as members. Dr BHAGAT was authorised to co-opt other members.

Dr Gyani while concluding the session, suggested that major hospitals must establish formal Home Health services. He also suggested that hospitals may work on converting hospital beds into HDUs/ ICU beds with minimum resources. He also advised counselling of Hospital employees by HODs to motivate them.
