Maharashtra - Mr. Joy Chakraborty

- Announced AHPI Global Conclave 2022 (dates to be finalized in coming week).
- Maharashtra state completed 10 crore (1 million) doses of vaccine.
- Registration charges being taken by all hospitals, but order needs to be challenged to avoid any trouble in future.

Madhya Pradesh - Dr. Anoop Hajela

• Excess doses of vaccine unutilized- needs a policy

Kerala - Dr. M I Sahadulla

- COVID condition not very favorable in Kerala with 7 thousand cases.
- Excess vaccine stocks need government directive.
- Shelf Life of Vaccine extended.
- Registration can be made lifetime with fees- suggestion

Jharkhand - Mr. Jogesh Gambhir

- Suggestion for Global Conclave- session on 10 easy steps for NABH (for nursing homes).
- Registration fee can be charged with a different name- Suggestion.
- Government should take back the excess stock of COVID vaccine or a directive for booster dose should be given.

Karnataka - Dr. Sushil Jathanna

- COVID cases are low and excess stock of vaccine present.
- Executive committee meeting happening every month.
- Launching Training program from 26th Nov. 2021.
